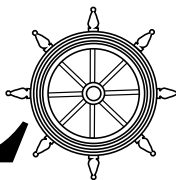

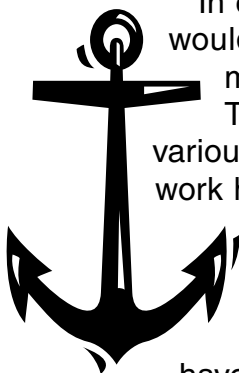

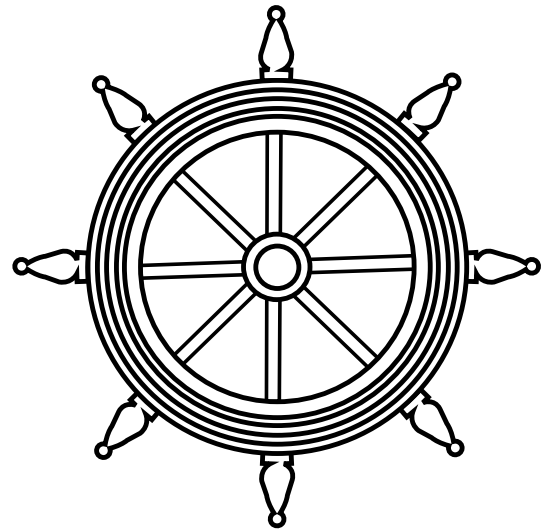

Also to renew Boat/US use our co-op group number GA83475Y. The rate is \$25.00 but by using our co-op group # , the rate is \$12.50 per year.

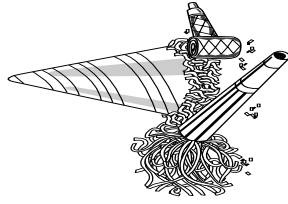
## **First Class News**

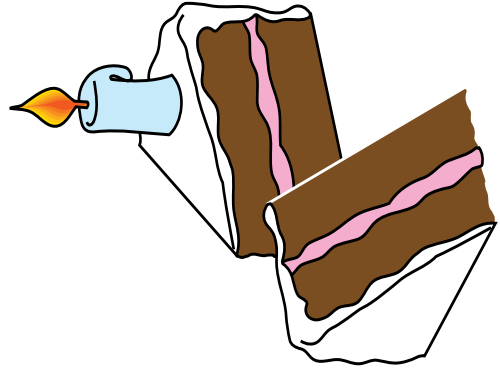
