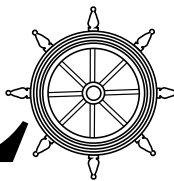

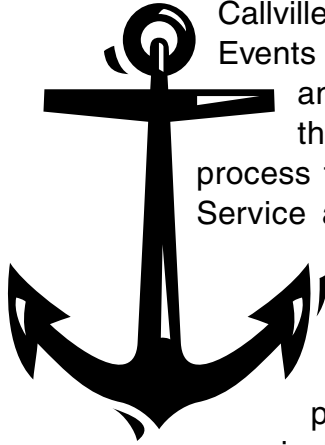

5. We seem to be having a few potlucks and it would be very nice if you could put your name on them or the recipe in the future. Thanks.




