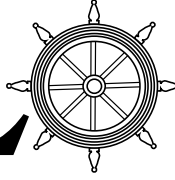

Annual Lake Mead Yacht Club Poker Run with Co-Sponsor Callville Bay Marina

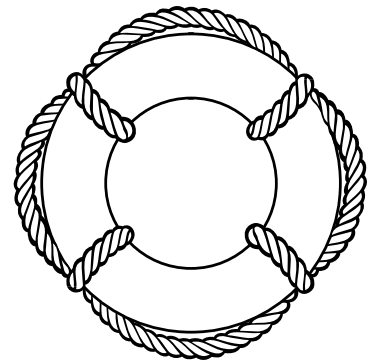
WHEN: Saturday, June 26th, 2004

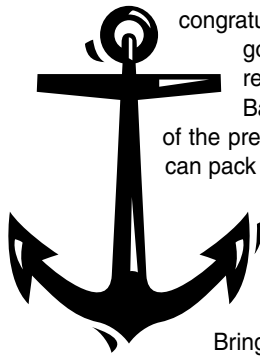

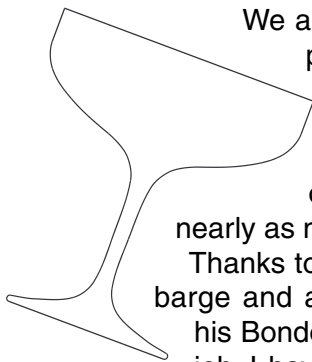

The dinner arrangements for Saturday night were very nice as we had our own room and bartenders.

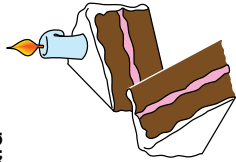

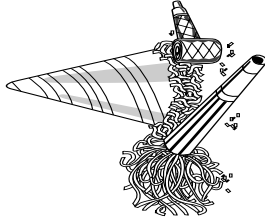

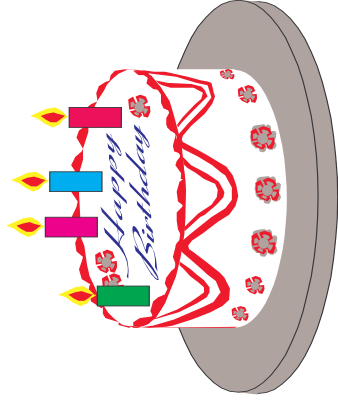
