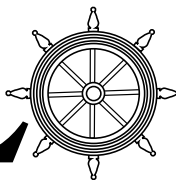

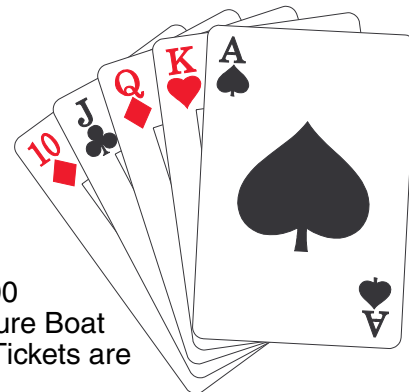
Annual Lake Mead Yacht Club/Callville Bay Marina POKER RUN

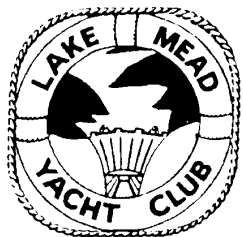

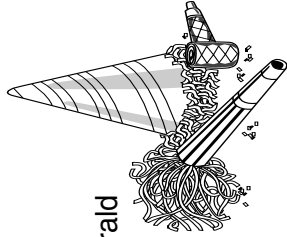
* * * First Class News * * *

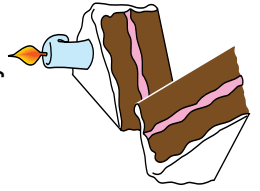

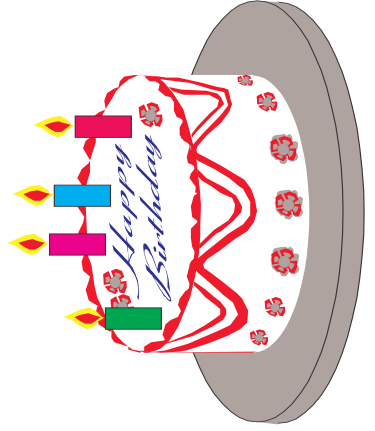
