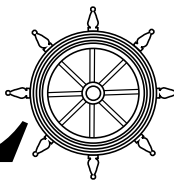

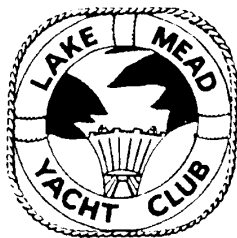

Message from the Commadore,

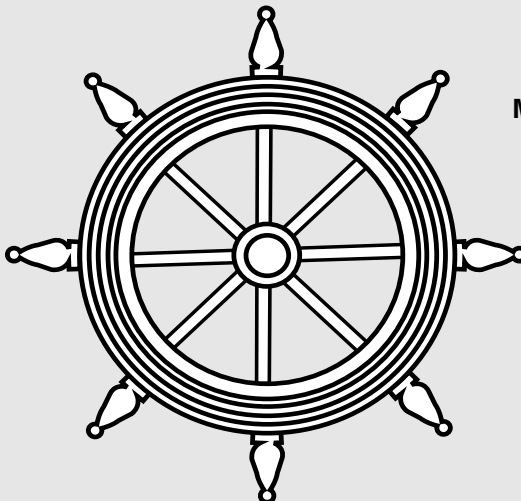

Lake Mead Yacht Club 2004 Poker Fun Run

Lake Mead Yacht Club with Co-sponsor Callville Bay Resort held the 2004 Lake Mead Poker Run on Saturday, June 26, 2004. There were 158 poker hands sold at \$25.00 each. Each entry included a free chance for raffle prizes, a picnic buffet with soda beverages, live entertainment, and a t-shirt/tank top.

The top prizes consisted of \$1,000 for the best hand, with second best at \$500 and third at \$250. The best hand was Mr. Tim Allen with three kings, Mr. Narousol with three jacks, and Mr. Mike Riley in third place winning with three eights.

Raffle prizes were donated by Callville Bay and West Marine. Callville Bay contributed a houseboat cruise for 4 days, rental on a patio boat, and three two-people rafting trips from Willow Beach through the black canyon below Hoover Dam. West Marine contributed various merchandise products from their custom lines which included ice coolers, cooler cups and hats.

There were five (5) stops in the lower basin and each one sponsored by a local merchant or marine company. The first stop was Rum Runner Bars, owned and operated by Mr. Geno Hill, second stop was Last Call Tavern located at 12360 Las Vegas Blvd. South. Last Call gave everyone an invitation for a complimentary lunch or dinner with the purchase of another at equal value. They also sponsored a contest for a free cruise to Ensenada, Mexico. The third stop, or half-way point was Las Vegas Boat Harbor. They gave away key chains and calendars, and provided a welcome relief in the form of free air conditioning. The next stop was Cobalt Marine Boats. They had three boats on display with the largest being a 36-foot cruiser used for the stop. The dealer is new in town and their participation was greatly appreciated. The final stop was Marine Performance Center and the team that worked the Run was as experienced as any

boater on the lake. Many thanks to the five sponsors and we sincerely expect everyone to support our new friends.

Each one of the card pick-up spots were described as a clue written by Commodore Finley. For those without the benefit of special lake knowledge, a map was provided.

The team of registration "specialists" was composed of LMYC members. The team worked from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. to be sure all participants were registered on the lake.

All hands were turned-in by 4:00 p.m. for recording and documenting. Another team from the LMYC were there to record all the hands. These recorders were Jim Lang, Joan Kilburn, Steve Jones, Ed Oliver, Al Garraway and Mike Pearce.

All festivities started at 4:00 with the buffet, music and raffle prizes. Guests were invited and everyone enjoyed the party.

A special thanks to Commodore Corwon Finley for the "take-charge" role which helped ensure the success of this event. Our host for the rewards ceremony was Mr. Geno Hill, who was the originator of the poker run on Lake Mead. His advice and counsel contributed to making this event successful.

3. Our facilities representative Tom Tedder reported the new pumps on the swamp cooler keep the club

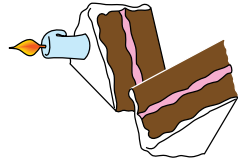
COOL and the icemakers operate, thanks to Charlie Barker and some board members? Didn't get their names, but it still goes—if you take some ice, bag some ice.

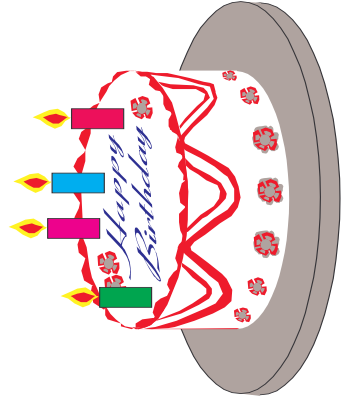

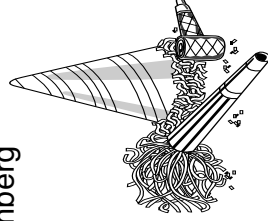
