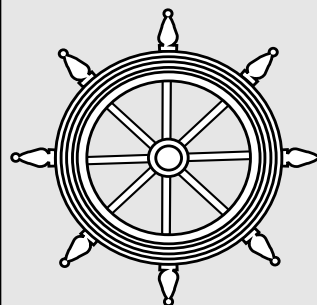
For the 81 attendees (45 members and 36 non-members) the night was **like oh my god**, unbelievable!

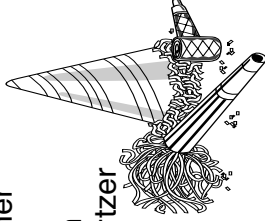

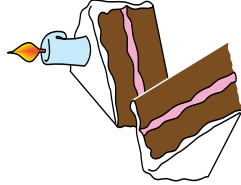
