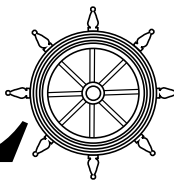

Message from the Commadore,

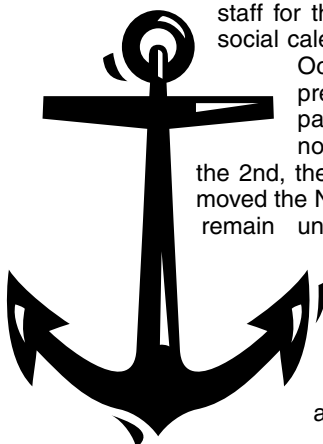
What is there left to say after Luau/Luau 2004? This is one event that just keeps getting bigger and better, thanks to all of the members that support your party hosts.
