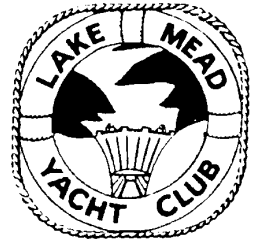
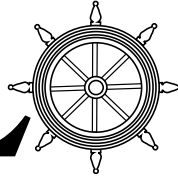

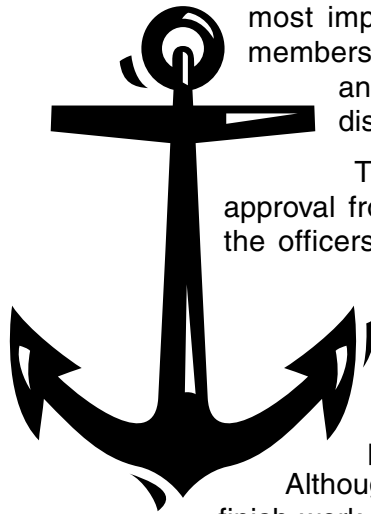

## Message from the Commadore,

As your 2005 Commadore, I was very pleased with the excellent turnout for the annual election of officers meeting, a most important annual event. We had over 80 members and guests present at the Fiesta Hotel and Casino in Henderson, Nevada when we discussed the future of our organization.



The first matter of business was the approval from the general membership authorizing the officers and Board of Trustees to move ahead with finishing the final details to start the construction of our new facility. The Facilities Committee submitted a total budget of \$150,000 for the flotation, steel building/erection, electrical, plumbing, AC, doors and windows.

Although this number does not include the final finish work or the furniture, fixtures, and equipment for the interior, it does provide a complete building that will replace the existing structure. With the funds from the organization and the donations provided during the meeting, we were able to move forward and order the flotation from Forever Resorts, the authorized concessionaire at Callville Bay Marina. As additional funds are generated over the next couple of months, we will proceed with acquiring the steel structure and the balance of the building materials. Callville Bay Management will secure all necessary approvals from the National Park Service. Within the next few weeks we should have a definitive time line for construction. This is a significant accomplishment for all those who have donated funds, time, and a tremendous amount of effort to get us to this point.

The second point of business was the election of Officers and the Board of Trustees for 2006. Mr. John Keith presented the slate and by a unanimous vote from the membership the slate was elected. I offer my congratulations to all the new Officers and Trustees. They will be charged with implementing the ongoing plans for our new facility and ensuring the financial success of our yacht club.

Those of you who could not attend this meeting truly missed a significant event in the history of the Yacht Club. The members participating in the vote determined the future course of this organization.
