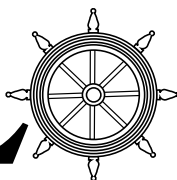

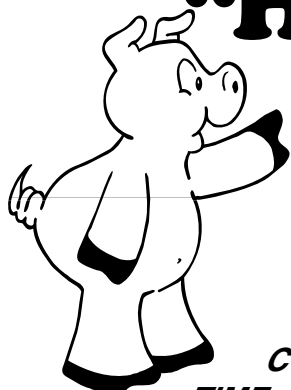

On Saturday, October 25th at 1pm we will have a fly over helicopter individual picture shoot out of Callville Bay. This shoot is for water shots while underway on your boat. Anyone interested in getting this done needs to call me at 242-2785 no later than Wednesday, October 22nd.

Details of the picture taking will be provided for you Saturday morning at our boat "Southern Ties" located at slip 2604 in Callville Bay. The timing of this event will be critical because the helicopter is \$60.00 per minute. Our price is the same as the Luau picture prices below.

The Yacht Club facility looks great with the new paint job and the new ice machines are doing their job as long as we have water supply. New members Marilyn & Chuck Kruse have offered to donate the necessary roof repairs for the club. 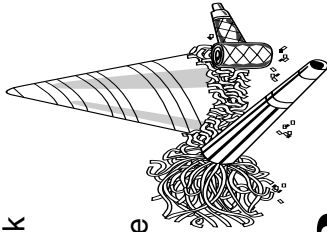

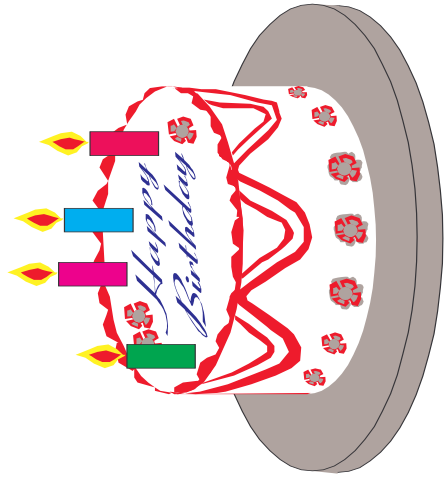

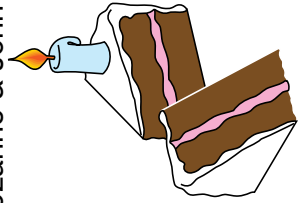
