Margarita blend-off ballots are counted and winners announced.

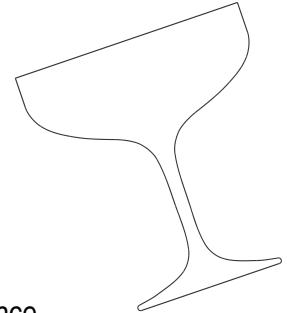
The club hosted margarita bar continues, possibly with a few new flavors, if the winners will make or share their recipes.

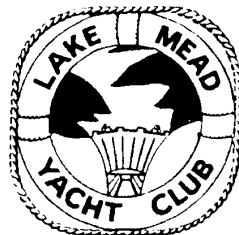

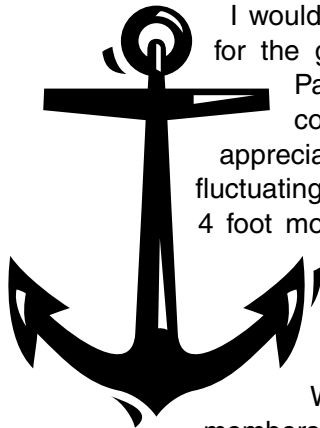

## \* \* First Class News \* \*

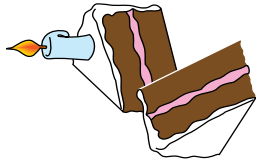
1. Since our phone has not worked for months, the service is being cancelled.

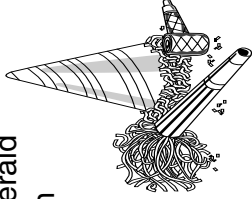
