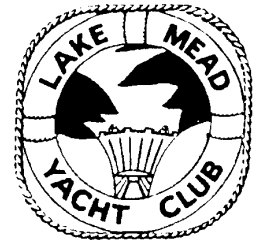
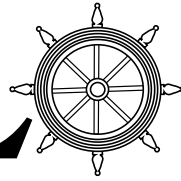

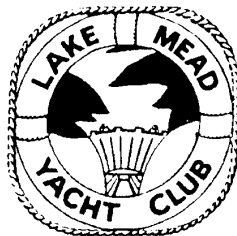

A.E.D. Machine

It has been suggested that the yacht club purchase an A.E.D. machine to be kept on the dock. This is the machine that is used to "Shock" a person that has gone into cardiac arrest. The AED is very simple to learn how to use. The cost is approx. \$3000 and would be collected by donations with the donators given a key to the dock box. Nevada law states you have to take a CPR class that includes AED training before you use one.

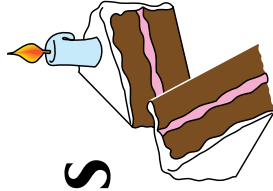
*** * First Class News * ***

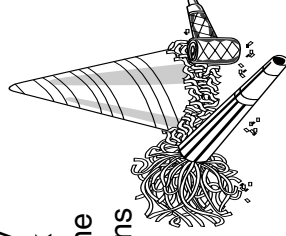

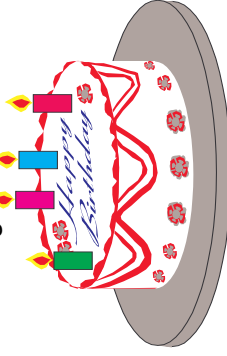
