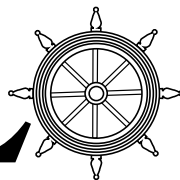

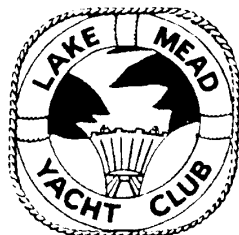
BOARD MEMBER CHANGES
