WHERE: Swallow Bay, south shore, GPS coordinates N36-07.273, W 114-45.364

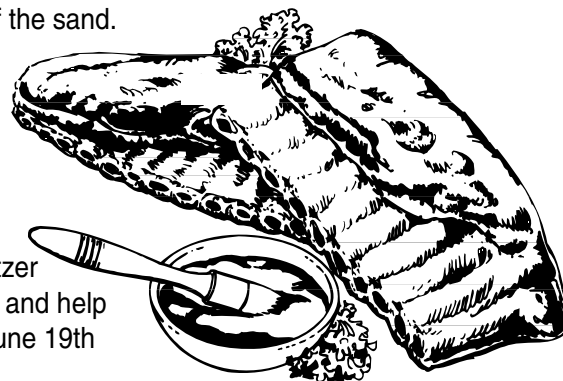
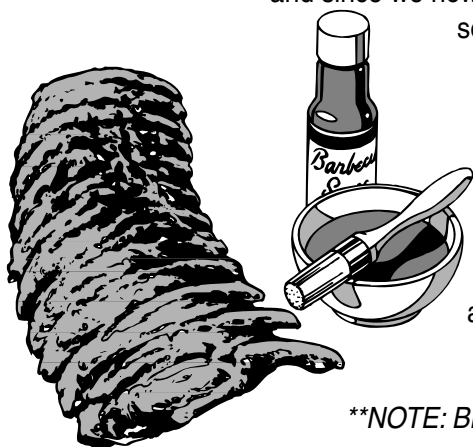
TIME: 7:00 P.M. • **COST:** \$20.00

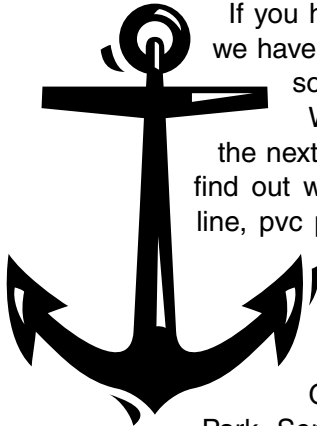

WORK PARTY

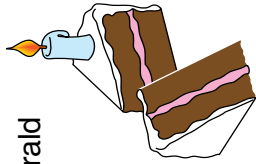

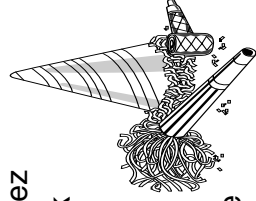
