We were told to revert back to former Superintendent O'Neill's letter dated February 25, 2002, which states in part that the club house is to be operated under the umbrella of the concessionaire, which means we are back to the drawing table with Callville.

Jim Gomes, General Manager of Callville Bay says they do not want to oversee the operations of our club as they have enough on their plate operating the marina. Mr. Gomes said there is a solution to this problem, but they have to concentrate on moving the marina by August 20th, then they will have time to meet with our government affairs committee. Mr. Gomes, in his next breath, said the 14th of July would be his last day at Callville Bay, then we will be working with a new general manager.

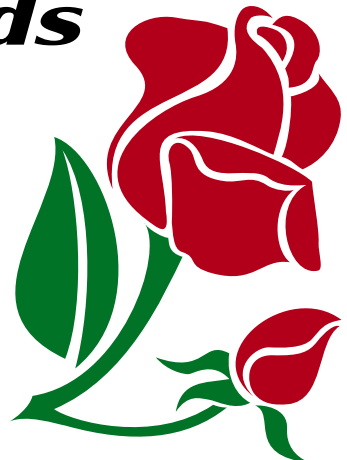
I would like to thank Mr. Gomes for a great job and we are looking forward to meeting our new general manager.

NEW TRUSTEE

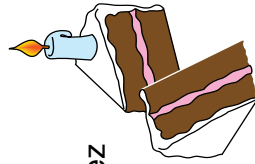

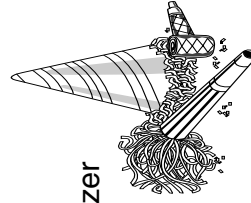
